

## NOTICE TO ARCHITECTS, ENGINEERS, AND PLANNERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the City of Oklahoma City has a certain Capital Improvement project that requires the services of a consulting firm.

In order to be considered, the Consultant must comply with the Resolution establishing procedure for "Selection of Architects, Engineers, and Planners" adopted by the City Council on November 18, 1986, a copy of which may be obtained at <http://www.okc.gov/pw/admin.html> or from the office of the Public Works Department Director.

The Project is as follows: Downtown Streetscape in the area bounded by Reno Avenue on the south, E.K. Gaylord Blvd. on the east, NW 6<sup>th</sup> Street on the north and Lee Avenue on the west. This project includes eighty two blocks of streetscaping in the downtown area to be separated into eight design contracts.

The concept plan is being prepared by a Landscape Architect and will be finalized in the near future. As a part of the conceptual plan, complete survey has been performed and will be available to each contracted consultant. Projects within each consultant contract will be bid over the next three years. Each firm must have the ability to coordinate and share their design data with the Landscape Architect Design Team, including but not limited to, the Landscape Architect, Utility Company, and stake holders in the downtown area.


Detailed descriptions, schedule and proposed contact packages are available on the Public Works website. The website will be updated periodically as information becomes available.
