



Vehicle for Hire & Other Transportation Services Driver Medical Certification

Job Description

Drivers of motor vehicles for hire and carriages are responsible for driving passengers to their destination, determining a route, maintaining the motor vehicle or carriage (and horses, if applicable) and obeying all federal, state and local traffic laws. Motor vehicle for hire and carriage drivers must also calculate and collect fares.

The driver must demonstrate they are physically capable of performing their job functions. At the minimum, an examination of the driver's hearing, alertness and eye-hand-foot coordination should demonstrate he or she can safely perform the functions of a driver with ordinary and reasonable control in the operation of a motor vehicle or carriage. The driver's vision acuity must comply with state statutory requirements and Department of Public Safety standards.
